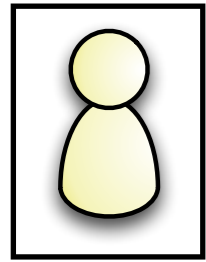
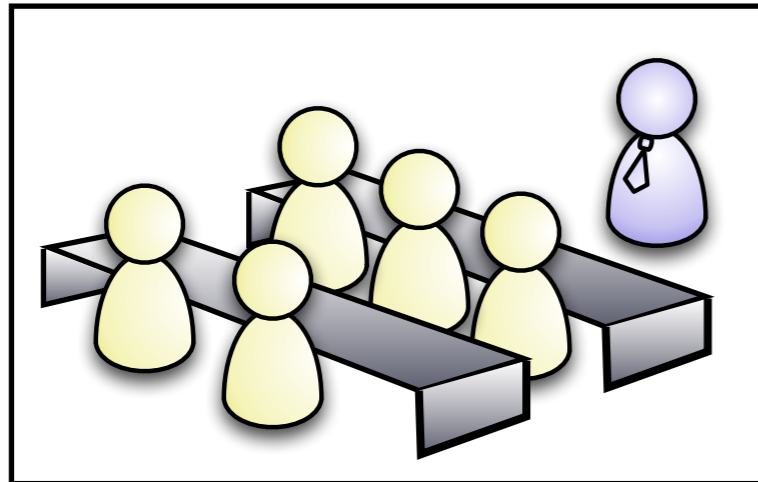
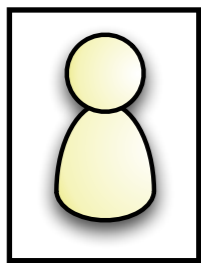


Simplified use of SWITCHpoint for distributed classrooms

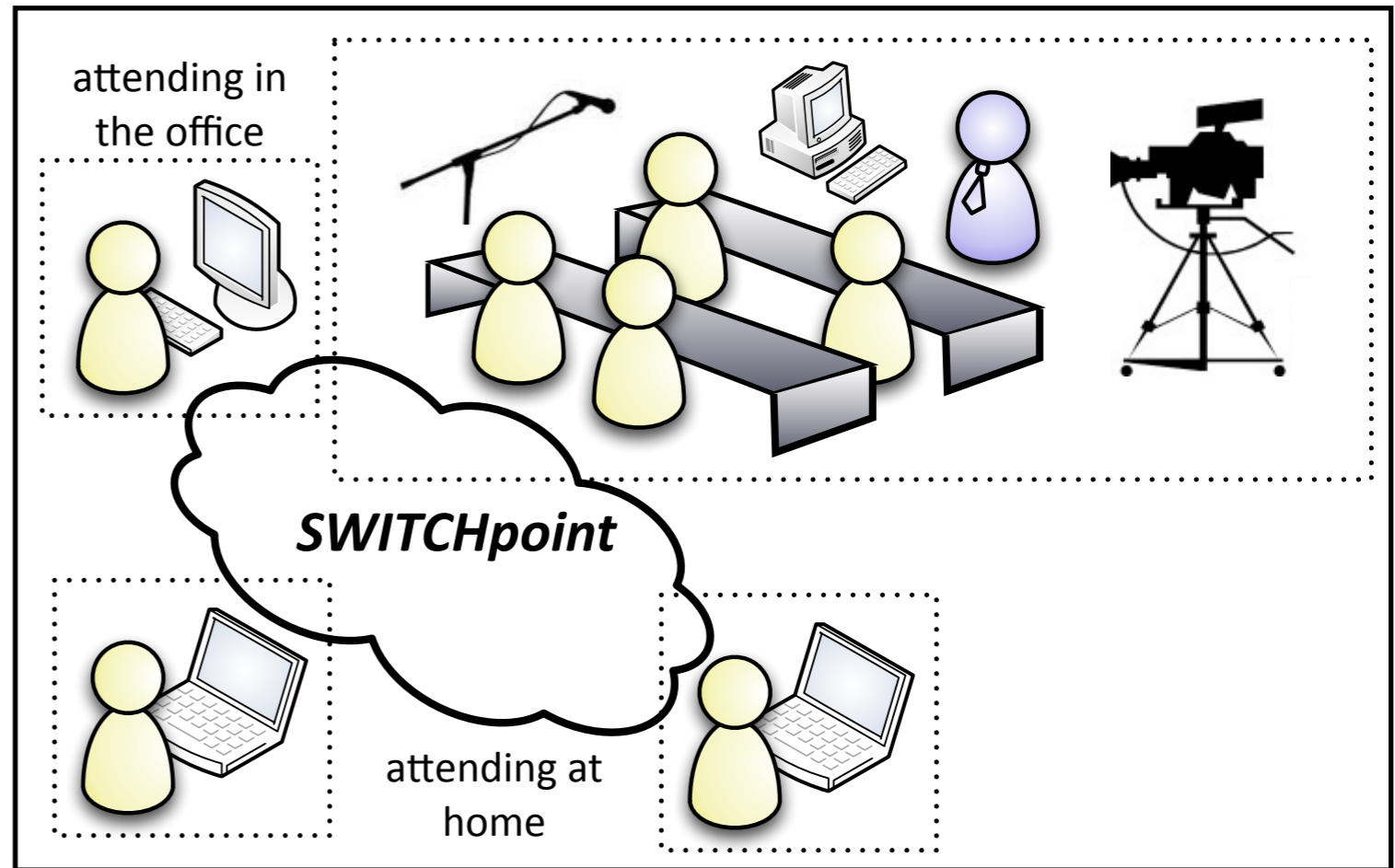

Project Idea

Development of a control box with a few connectors, push-buttons, knobs and rulers as an accessory for the equipment needed to run a SWITCHpoint web conference.

With the hardware box, even unexperienced lecturers will be able to switch between presentation and desktop sharing or to let a remote student ask a question.

Instead of controlling the SWITCHpoint Software with mouse clicks, the lecturers will control it by simply pushing a few buttons. The control box will be connected to the keyboard of the lecturer's computer or laptop and issue keyboard shortcuts to activate the appropriate SWITCHpoint features.
