v add explanatory notes to or supply with critical comments

"The scholar annotated the early edition of a famous novel"

Synonyms: [footnote](#)

Type of: [compose](#), [indite](#), [pen](#), [write](#)
produce a literary work

v provide interlinear explanations for words or phrases

"He annotated on what his teacher had written"

Synonyms: [comment](#), [gloss](#)

Type of: [interpret](#), [rede](#)
give an interpretation or explanation to

Features

What can SWITCHcast annotate do?

- Text annotations & Structured annotations
- Comments
- Sharing annotations
- Looping
- Print & Export

What can I do with SWITCHcast annotate?

- Communication training
- Situation analysis (e.g. sports)
- Statistical analysis
- Mentor or peer feedback

Who can annotate what?

A user can annotate **any event** on SWITCHcast if he/she ...

- has a SWITCHaai / edu-id account
- has permissions to view the event

... and the serie producer has ...

- allowed annotations for the events in the serie

- ▶ AAA-Project “Annotating Academic Video”
- ▶ Goal: Open source video annotation service
 - ▶ Suitable for academic settings
 - ▶ Can work in conjunction with different video-, learning- und content management systems
 - ▶ Integration into SWITCHcast, opencast, Moodle (and ILIAS)
