What is annotate

add explanatory notes to or supply with critical comments

"The scholar annotated the early edition of a famous novel"

Synonyms: <u>footnote</u>

Type of: compose, indite, pen, write

produce a literary work

provide interlinear explanations for words or phrases

"He **annotated** on what his teacher had written"

Synonyms: comment, gloss

Type of: interpret, rede

give an interpretation or explanation to

- has permissions to view the event


... and the serie producer has ...

- AAA-Project "Annotating Academic Video"
- Goal: Open source video annotation service
 - Suitable for academic settings
 - Can work in conjunction with different video-, learning- und content management systems
 - Integration into SWITCHcast, opencast, Moodle (and ILIAS)
