



Guidelines for SWITCH events during the coronavirus pandemic

In light of the current restrictions imposed as a result of coronavirus, physical attendance at SWITCH events is possible as long as measures are in place. The following guidelines are based on the recommendations of the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH), in particular concerning hygiene and physical distancing. They must be adhered to by all attendees:

- Attendance is only permitted after registering with a name, email address and phone number. This information must be provided either when registering online or at the venue to ensure that attendees can be traced.
- The maximum number of attendees is limited and depends on the venue. This number is published for each event and strictly adhered to. Online registrations made in advance take priority over spontaneous registrations at the venue. If the event is booked out, SWITCH will not grant entry to additional attendees.
- Hand disinfectant and face masks are available at the venue.
- Seating is arranged so that attendees can maintain the required minimum distance. This distance must also be maintained outside the meeting rooms. If this isn't possible, SWITCH recommends that attendees wear a face mask.
- All attendees must adhere to the guidelines published by the FOPH, which will be displayed at the venue. SWITCH reserves the right to ask anyone who isn't adhering to these guidelines to leave the event.
- SWITCH is currently not providing catering because doing so would prevent it from complying with the FOPH's guidelines. Attendees must bring their own food or find a restaurant with safety guidelines in place.
